
Occupied Palestinian Territory: Gaza emergency Humanitarian Snapshot (as of 20 July 2014)

Situation Overview


On 17 July the Israeli army launched a ground incursion into the Gaza Strip and intensified airstrikes and artillery shelling, triggering a sharp increase in civilian casualties and mass displacements

Up to 60 Palestinians, including 17 children and 14 women, are reported to have been killed in the past 24 hours in the Ash Shuja'iyeh area in eastern Gaza City, raising concern about respect for the principle of distinction and proportionality under international humanitarian law. The depletion of stocks and the access impediments are increasingly challenging humanitarian operations.

Damaged structures




oPt Funding by sector (in million US\$)
